How to reach the Kulturhaus

Our seminar house in Osterholz-Scharmbeck region which is located around 50 minutes by bus from Bremen's main train station. There are only a few buses per day.

You need to catch the BUS 660 (direction: Hagen i. Br.) from Bremen main station. Your bus stop is: Garlstedt BW Logistikschule, Osterholz-Scharmbeck. Other connections might not work because they have very few time to change from train to bus, so the reliable option is the 660


